[AudiFab Apple Music Converter for Mac](#) is specially designed for Mac users to convert Apple Music/iTunes songs, playlists, audiobooks, podcasts or other downloaded M4P music, to MP3, WAV, FLAC, AAC, ALAC and AIFF format. Built-in with a top-ranking recording core, AudiFab Apple Music Converter enables to download all of your Apple Music playlists with lossless audio quality kept, particularly well suited for those who pursue high sound quality. It will help you download songs from Apple Music and iTunes for streaming them on any of your devices. It also supports retaining ID3 tags for Apple Music songs, like Title, Artist, Album, Artwork, Track number, and more. More importantly, you can also edit the ID3 tags information and convert the format of local audio files on AudiFab's toolbox as your preference.

Key Features

- Record music, podcasts, audiobooks from Apple Music/iTunes;
- Convert Apple Music songs, podcasts, audiobooks to MP3, AAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC, or FLAC;
- Keep ID3 tags, such as artist, album, track number;
- Support to edit ID3 tags & convert local music;
- Convert Apple Music songs with lossless quality kept.
- Support the latest macOS 15.


2. What benefits do we have after registration?

Register AudiFab Apple Music Converter

Step 1: Launch AudiFab Apple Music Converter. Click the "**Register**" icon on the upper-right corner and you will see the registration window as below.



Step 2: Please fill the input blanks with your registration Email and registration key. You may use **Ctrl+C** to copy and **Ctrl+V** to paste in the window. Then please click **Register** button.

The registration code is case sensitive, please do not add blank at the beginning or the end of the word. You can also copy and paste the registration information into the registration popup dialog.

Step 3: After you finished the registration, the limitation of the trial version will be removed.

Notice:

1. Make sure both the Email address and registration code are provided by our company after you pay the registration fee. If you have not paid, please click **Buy Now** to buy online.
2. Please make sure the Email address and registration code you entered are complete and correct.


Installation

3. Install AudiFab Apple Music Converter.

Main Interface


Launch AudiFab Apple Music Converter on Mac. You will see the main interface like this:






Converting Interface

When clicking the menu bar, you will see the menu list like this:








Record Music from Web


Launch the AudiFab Apple Music Converter. Record Apple Music from Webplayer. Sign in your Apple Music account.






Import Audio Files

Step 1: Find a playlist. Click the “Add” button and you will see a pop-up window showing songs on AudiFab.



Step 2: Locate and select the files you want to add, click the **Add** button to get prepared for conversion.





Delete Audio Files

If you don't want to convert certain music, please click "X" button to remove this music before converting. If you want to delete all of the songs you choose, please click "Delete All" on the upper left corner.




Choose Output Settings

Click the **"Settings"** button on the program interface, and then there will be a pop-up window which prompts you to set Convert Settings and Output Settings.



Customize OutputPath

Click **"Settings"** on the bottom left of your Mac, there will be a window pops up and then you can change the output path in the popup window.




Tips: If you don't change the output path, the converted files will be saved in AudiFab Apple Music Converter default folder.



Convert Audio Files

After adding the Audio files and customizing output path, please click the “**Convert**” button to start the conversion.





Check Conversion History


When the conversion is done, please click **"Converted"** button on the left side to show up the records.

You can also check the converted files by directly going to the output folder you set.



Edit ID3 Tags


The program retains the original quality of Apple Music and keeps all ID3 tags after conversion. And you can also edit all the important and useful Meta information by clicking **"Tools > Edit Tag"**.






Convert Local Audio

AudiFab Apple Music Converter also supports to convert the local music to MP3/M4A/AAC/WAV/OGG/AIFF format. Simply open AudiFab, click "**Tools > Format Converter**", and then add the music from your computer to convert.



Convert AA/AAX Audiobooks

There is a paid tool call A/AAX Converter, which can help you convert local aa or aax audiobooks to M4A, M4B or MP3 format easily.







Split Audio into Vocals and Accompaniment

AI Audio Splitter is a powerful and easy-to-use tool that can separate audio into different stems, such as vocals, accompaniment, and instruments, using AI models. You can choose from various separation schemes/models according to your quality and speed requirements. You can also adjust the volume and other parameters of the separated stems.

AI Audio Splitter can be used for various scenarios, such as:

- Separating vocals for audio editing and processing
- Separating accompaniment for karaoke, making backing tracks, or merging your own recordings
- Separating different instrument sounds for remixing, sampling, or learning
